## SCRIPTURE LESSONS

**Jeremiah 11:18-20** *(on back)* In the Old Testament Lesson, the prophet Jeremiah serves God and finds himself despised by unbelievers who are planning evil against him. Jeremiah leaves their judgment into the LORD's hand.

### RESPONSIVE READING – Psalm 119:33-40

*The Psalmist seeks God's help in living by His standards and His continual instruction for life.*

Pastor: Teach me, O LORD, to follow Your decrees;

**Congregation: Then I will keep them to the end.**

P: Give me understanding, and I will keep Your law and obey it with all my heart.

**C: Direct me in the path of Your commands, for there I find delight.**

P: Turn my heart toward Your statutes and not toward selfish gain.

**C: Turn my eyes away from worthless things; preserve my life according to Your word.**

P: Fulfill Your promise to Your servant, so that You may be feared.

**C: Take away the disgrace I dread, for Your laws are good.**

P: How I long for Your precepts!

**C: Preserve my life in Your righteousness. Amen.**



**James 3:13-18** *(on back)* The Epistle tells us that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Here we see qualities that God determines as true wisdom.

SERMON - NIV Mark 9:30-37 30 They left that place and passed through Galilee. Jesus did not want anyone to know where they were, 31 because he was teaching his disciples. He said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise." 32 But they did not understand what he meant and were

afraid to ask him about it. 33 They came to Capernaum. When he was in the house, he asked them, "What were you arguing about on the road?" 34 But they kept quiet because on the way they had argued about who was the greatest. 35 Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, "If anyone wants to be first, he must be the very last, and the servant of all." 36 He took a little child and had him stand among them. Taking him in his arms, he said to them, 37 "Whoever welcomes one of these little children in my name welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me does not welcome me but the one who sent me."
