Second Reading

John 14:1-12 (NKJV)

[Jesus said:] "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.

² "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. ⁴ "And where I go you know, and the way you know."

- ⁵ Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"
- ⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. ⁷ " If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."
 - ⁸ Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."
- ⁹ Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? ¹⁰ "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. ¹¹ "Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. ¹² " Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

² Like newborn babies, crave the pure milk of the word so that by it you may grow up with the result being salvation. ³ Certainly you have tasted that the Lord is good! ⁴ As you come to him, the Living Stone, rejected by men but chosen by God and precious, ⁵ you also, like living stones, are being built as a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, in order to bring spiritual sacrifices that are acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. ⁶ For it says in Scripture:

See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who believes in him will certainly not be put to shame.

⁷Therefore, for you who believe, this is an honor. But for those who do not believe:

The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,

⁸ and,

a stone over which they stumble and a rock over which they fall.




Because they continue to disobey the word, they stumble over it. And that is the consequence appointed for them.

P Let us give thanks unto the Lord, our God.




The words spoken by Jesus the night He instituted the Lord's Supper by which our Lord assured to His Church the real presence of His sacramental body and blood for all time.

The Word of God treats the Lord's Supper with great care. The Word of God considers the Lord's Supper to be a wonderful Means of Grace – a way in which Christ forgives and blesses. It is also considered an opportunity for congregations to express unity and oneness (1 Corinthians 10:16-17) – that is, to say to the world "This is what we believe!" But God's Word also warns against taking the Sacrament to our judgment (1 Corinthians 11:27-30). For these reasons our congregation asks that you fully understand our teachings before partaking. THE BENEDICTION


The blessing given by God for the blessing of His people (Numbers 6:24-26).
