Confession and Absolution


We come before our Holy God recognizing that we are sinful and daily need His forgiveness.

Confession of Faith - 1st Article of the Apostles' Creed with Luther's Explanation (Sydow Catechism, p. 97)

I believe in God the Father almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

I believe that God has created me and all creatures.

He has given me my body and life, eyes, ears, and all my bodily members, my mind, and all my senses and still keeps them for me.

God also preserves me by richly and daily providing clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, spouse and children, land, animals, and all my property and all I need to support this body and life.

He protects me from all danger. He guards and defends me from every evil. God does all this because He is my good and gracious Father in heaven, not because of anything I have done to earn or deserve it.

Sermon Text: John 6:25-35 (EHV)

²⁵ When they found him on the other side of the sea, they asked him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?"

²⁶ Jesus answered them, "Amen, Amen, I tell you: You are not looking for me because you saw the miraculous signs, but because you ate the loaves and were filled. ²⁷ Do not continue to work for the food that spoils, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

- ²⁸ So they said to him, "What should we do to carry out the works of God?"




